Serah Okechukwa with Birch Creek Development called to discuss decommissioning documents, required building permits and a road use agreement for the solar farm in Hamilton.

Commissioners met with Terry Rumery to discuss economic development for Caldwell County.


Commissioner Akey agreed to follow up with IHP on boiler maintenance.
